## Taiwanese Gourmet Cuisine International Tour Brings Taste of Taiwan to Canterbury



On September 28th 2024, Taiwan Centre for Mandarin Learning in the UK – Chinese Learning Paradise, led by Headmistress Crystal Tseng, hosted the 2024 International Tour of Taiwanese Gourmet Cuisine in Canterbury. This exclusive event was the chefs' only stop in the UK during their European-African world tour, showcasing Taiwan's rich culinary heritage.

Sponsored by the Taiwanese government, the event featured live cooking demonstrations by two of Taiwan's top-ranked chefs. The culinary masters prepared seven traditional Taiwanese dishes: General Tso's Chicken, Golden Kimchi, Tomatoes in Plum Sauce, Taiwanese Steamed Glutinous Rice, Three-Cup Basil Mushroom, Taiwanese Sausages, and Crispy Cheese Milk Triangles for dessert.

The event kicked off with a traditional Taiwanese folk fan dance, performed by staff members, setting the tone for an immersive cultural experience.

Among the distinguished attendees were representatives from local mainstream schools, local community groups and government public sectors, including: Mr Shih-Chih Chen - Director of the Taipei Representative Office in the UK; Mr Paul Pollard - Headteacher of Simon Langton Girls' Grammar School; Mr Tom Hunt and Ms Melissa Davies - senior management team members of Bleas Primary School; Tam Clark and Marieke Starling - members of the Canterbury Fire and Rescue Service and Kent Police; and Mr. Frank Hao - minister of Canterbury Chinese Christian Church.

During the demonstration, the chefs expertly explained each dish, captivating the audience. Guests expressed their admiration, praising the organisers for presenting such a unique and memorable experience, and wished for further opportunities to explore Taiwan's vibrant food culture in the future.



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
